

Aug. 6, 1946

The Rosbury Township Planning Board, acting as a zoning Commission, met with the officials of the North Jersey Quarry Company on the Corwin Tract, Dell Ave., Kenil, N.J., at 6:30 P.M.

The purpose of this meeting was to go over properties involved, before the final adoption of the proposed Zoning Map for Rosbury Township.

After the task of inspection and survey of the North Jersey Quarry Company property, the zoning Commission went to the Baker pit, belonging to Dequire Bogart Co, which lies between Route #6 and the Central Railroad, Kenil. Here also a survey was made.

Leaving the Baker Pit the zoning Commission went to the Succasunna Grammar School for the evening meeting.

The meeting was opened with Thomas James presiding.

The North Jersey Quarry Company requests were discussed, resulting in changes on the proposed Zoning Map of property north of Route #6.

The motion was made by Frank Wufford.

Seconded by Oscar Benson. Vote -
unanimous by Commission.

The North Jersey Lumber Company
property south of Route #16 - Changes
as per zoning Map.

The motion for these changes was
made by Frank Dufford. Seconded
by Frank Pease. Commission voted
unanimously.

Baker Pit belonging to Sequine
Bogart Company, Kenil, south of
Route #6 - Changes as per zoning
Map include west of said Map,
Hillside Ave., 200 feet north of Central
railroad and Modern Furniture.

Motion by Oscar Benson
Seconded by Elmer Stephens
Vote - unanimous.

Letter from Mr. Joseph Francis Jr.
was read regarding billboards and
signs. After lengthy discussion it
was decided to have the Township
attorney draw up something regulating
billboards and signs.

Frank Pease mentioned the
incorrect reading of the proposed
Zoning Ordinance referring to garage
in the Business "C" Zone.
