

Fenimore Landfill Update

Saturday, August 24 - Monday, August 26, 2013



DEP and its contractors are working on-site 24/7 to resolve the H2S odor problem.

Landfill Site Work

DEP and Handex continue to evaluate the data from the vent testing. Pipes continue to be assembled on site as part of the construction of the gas collection system. DEP will continue providing updates on the progress.

Landfill Air Monitoring

At the request of town officials, ambient air samples were collected at the landfill overnight from August 15 to 16. These samples were analyzed for volatile organic compounds (VOCs) that are commonly found in the air, and the data is being reviewed.

Additional Air Monitoring

DEP's air team has determined that two additional H2S monitors should be added to the existing monitoring network located generally to the north and south of the landfill. DEP will be working with Roxbury's contractor to get the monitors installed as soon as possible. This will bring the total number of monitors to five.

A Look Ahead

Work on the site will continue 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
