Girls Lacrosse Signups

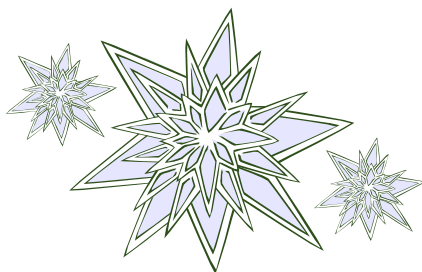

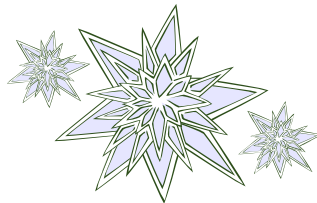
