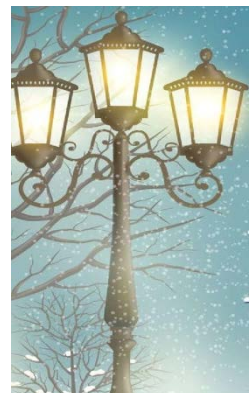
Roxbury Township's Home for the Holiday
