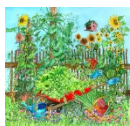


Vintage Vendors Wanted

Prevent Lyme Disease

Wear repellent - use a repellent with 20% DEET; plus, clothing treated with Permethrin kills ticks. Check for ticks daily on yourself and your children; ticks like to hide in folds of skin and in the hair. Check your pets too! Shower soon after being outdoors to remove ticks. Tumble clothes in a hot dryer to kill hidden ticks.

Call your doctor if you get a fever or rash. A Lyme disease rash may appear within 3 – 30 days, followed by fever, muscle and joint pain, or fatigue. For further information please visit these websites:

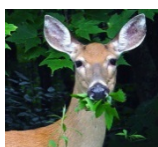
