



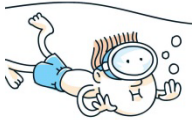

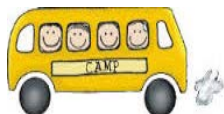
Girls Basketball Camps

Community School Summer Camps

Garden Club at Kennedy School –Gardening Club meets at the Kennedy School Garden for grades PreK-4 in July. This program meets rain or shine. Calling All Kids (Ages 3-5) –The program is designed to meet the developmental needs of students ages 3-5 (PreK and Kindergarten). Each day the program meets, a variety of components are integrated into the course of the day. These components include, but are not limited to morning meeting, literacy lesson, which integrates the curriculum areas, gross motor/movement lesson, fine motor development through a variety of hands-on projects, reinforcement of socialization and life skills. This program will include music, dance, free play, story time, arts and crafts! All children MUST be toilet trained and 3 years old as of October 1, 2016. Ceramics – During the weeks of summer ceramics classes' students will be learning hand building, pottery techniques for making ceramic forms which may include self-portraits of them, animal's features, clay faces, slab masks sculpting lessons, pottery forms like bases, bowls, or plates. They will use slabs and coils to model and mold projects, and colorful under glazes to complete their work. All work will be fired in the kiln.
