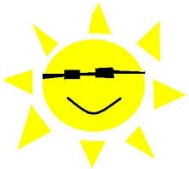

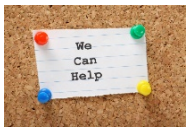

In the coming months inspectors from Appraisal Systems, Inc. will visit your property, measuring and photographing only the exterior of all buildings and inspecting the interior. 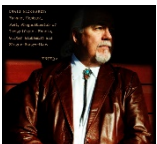
