We have such an outstanding summer **Playground Program** planned for your children! If you are a returning “camper,” you know that we try to pack as many stimulating activities into the 5-weeks as possible. Please read through the following information:

Kennedy Playground Camp starts on Monday, June 28, 2021 and runs through Friday, July 30, 2021. Please drop your child(ren) off at 9:00am and pick them up at 12:00pm. We will not have any counselors stay past 12pm, so please pick them up on time. Please remember to park and walk your child(ren) to the gym entrance on the side of the building, not the office entrance. **Friday, July 2nd – Wear: Red, White, & Blue. Note: there is no camp on July 5th. Calendar of events to follow.**

If your child is going to be picked up by someone else, please let the director of your camp know in writing; pick-up forms and all other forms were emailed previously and can be found on our website. Be prepared to show ID upon pick-up until we get to know you.

Each camper will receive Grab and Go lunch from Maschio’s each day at camp. If your child has a food allergy, please let us know. If you wish for your child not to receive the lunch, please let the director of the camp with a written note. The lunch items will vary each day and we will not know till the day of delivery. It is required to bring a drink each day. Snacks are allowed. Please provide sufficient water when the weather is hot. Children are allowed to bring a small bag for snacks, water and sunscreen. Please be sure to label all of your child’s items. All camps are peanut- free; please do not bring any peanut products.

All personal belongings such as toys, games, electronic devices, cell phones and other items should be left at home. The Roxbury Recreation Camp Staff, Roxbury Recreation Department and the Roxbury Board of Education are not responsible if these items are lost or stolen. *If there is a situation where a cell phone is needed for camp, please speak to your director about arrangements. No social media is permitted during camp.

At all times, your child should be wearing athletic sneakers or other proper play shoes. Flip flops, crocs, sandals, and other forms of open-toed shoes are dangerous in an environment full of play and outdoor activities. Please wear your camp shirt on trip days.

Please fill out and email the Medical Waiver and the Code of Conduct to darling1@roxburynj.us by Saturday so that the camps have them for Monday. If a camper needs an EPI-Pen or other medical device, all supplies need to be in a labeled Ziplock bag.
